## **MUNSON NAMED TO IMPORTANT COMPUTER TECHNOLOGY SUBCOMMITTEES**

**SPRINGFIELD**...Quickly becoming the Illinois House computer technology guru, State Representative Ruth Munson (R-Elgin) was recently named Chairwoman of the Computer Technology Subcommittee on Rural Access to Broadband, and was appointed to serve on the Human Services Appropriations Subcommittee on Computer Technology and the Legislative Information System Task Force.

“The Rural Access Subcommittee will deal with the problem of providing needed Internet broadband access to the rural areas of our state,” said Munson, Founder and President of EveryWare Inc., a software development firm.

The selection of Munson was easy due to her vast background and experience on the subject. “The expertise Ruth brings to the General Assembly is crucial as our state’s technology needs continue to evolve,” said House Republican Leader Tom Cross (R-Oswego). “Her input will be very beneficial to the people of Illinois.”

The Subcommittee on Rural Access to Broadband will hold their first meeting this Thursday morning in Springfield. Representative Munson is excited for the challenges lying ahead of her as Chairwoman.

“Illinois farmers are craving broadband services to help them receive continuous data on weather, commodity futures and other information that would help them become more efficient producers,” Munson said. “I am ready to get to work to help them do so.”
